In stark contrast to the resurgence of "America First" rhetoric, Black and Latinx intellectuals and organizers today have historically urged the United States to build bridges of solidarity with the nations of the Americas. National Institute of Health (NIH), LGBT advocacy groups, clinicians, and service providers.
